Regular Mission/Vision:

The World Food Programme (WFP) is the leading humanitarian organization saving lives and changing lives, delivering food assistance in emergencies and working with communities to improve nutrition and build resilience.

Regular Programs: A UN Organization.

- On any given day, WFP has 5,600 trucks, 30 ships and nearly 100 planes on the move, delivering food and other assistance to those in most need. These numbers lie at the roots of WFP's unparalleled reputation as an emergency responder, one that gets the job done quickly at scale in the most difficult environments.
- WFP's efforts focus on emergency assistance, relief and rehabilitation, development aid and special operations. Two-thirds of our work is in conflict-affected countries where people are three times more likely to be undernourished than those living in countries without conflict.
- WFP partners with more than 900 national and international NGOs to provide food assistance and tackle the underlying causes of hunger.

Ukraine Crisis Response:

- The war in Ukraine and sanctions on Russia will cause food shortages and double the costs of transporting food to the most vulnerable populations around the world. The Black Sea basin is one of the world's most important areas for grain and agricultural production. The consequences of the conflict will increase pressure on resources and access to food beyond Ukraine's borders.
- WFP is scaling up to reach 3.15 million Ukrainians through cash-based transfers as well as in-kind food distributions. WFP is also preparing to provide assistance to displaced Ukrainians in refugee hosting countries.
